Dear Deputy Commissioner Sotos:

Enclosed for the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection’s (“DEEP”) review are copies of the 2019 to 2021 combined Electric and Natural Gas Conservation and Load Management Plan (the “2019-2021 Plan”) and the 2019 Program Savings Document (“PSD”). The 2019-2021 Plan and 2019 PSD are submitted by The Connecticut Light and Power Company (“CL&P”) doing business as Eversource Energy (“Eversource”), The United Illuminating Company (“United Illuminating”), The Connecticut Natural Gas Corporation (“CNG”), The Southern Connecticut Gas Company (“SCG”), and Yankee Gas Services Company (“Yankee Gas”) doing business as Eversource Energy, (collectively the “Companies”) pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 16-245m(d).

The Companies have worked closely with the Energy Efficiency Board and its consultants to develop the 2019-2021 Plan. The 2019-2021 Plan was submitted to the Energy Efficiency Board for approval and the voting results on October 31, 2018 were as follows: 6 approval votes, 2 disapproval votes, 1 abstain, and DEEP abstaining from voting. DEEP abstains from voting on Plan



approvals at the Board on the basis that the Plans are transmitted to DEEP for DEEP's review and approval.
