A utility-approved technician will evaluate your home's energy performance and install basic weatherization and energy-saving measures.

Services can include:

- Health and safety evaluation
- Sealing air leaks and ductwork
- Installing hot water pipe wrap, faucet aerators and low-flow showerheads

The average home in Connecticut receives about \$950 in services and realizes \$180 in savings on their annual energy bills. Additionally, the technician will provide written recommendations for deeper energy-saving measures such as advanced duct sealing, insulation, high-efficiency heating, cooling and water heating equipment, windows and appliances.
